The railway is on a forested property owned by the City of Burnaby. We have approx. 4 kilometers of 7-1/2-inch gauge track. The locomotives are typically 1/8 of a full-size train. The park includes Rainbow Station, with museum exhibits, the Garden Railway, concession, party tents, public seating area and maintenance facilities.
